**Rules and Regulations**

We organized the Rexroth Cup for the first time in 1994, in Eger. This year the 33<sup>nd</sup> cup will be organized, which is called JP Autó - Suzuki Cup due to the change of the main sponsor.

The cup is organized by: Egri Focisuli SE

Place of the cup: Eger, Északi Sporttelep

Time of the cup: 20 - 23. June 2026.

Programme of the cup:

- group matches, pre-finals: 20 - 22. June 2026
- finals: 23. June 2026, 9:00 - 12:00
- announcement of results: 23. June 2026 at 12:15

**Schedule of the Cup:**

In all age groups the result of the group matches will determine the ranking.

**U-14,  
U-12 Girls:** After the group matches the fourth and the third teams of the group will play the bronze match, the second and the first team of the group will play the final.

**U-13, U-12,  
U-10, U-9,  
U-8:** After the group matches the best four teams from the groups will qualify to the playoff.

**U-11:** After the group matches the best three teams from the six teams' groups, the best two teams from the five teams' group will qualify to the playoff.

The winner gets 3 points at the group matches, if the match ended in a tie the teams get 1-1 point. The qualification is based on the points, the goal difference, the more scores and finally the result of the match with each other. If these are equal, we decide the qualification with draw. In the play-off and in the matches for the third and first place, if the match ended in a tie, 3-3 penalty kick will decide due to the rules of FIFA.

For boys, 1-year older girls and one 2-years older girl can play in the tournament. For girls one 1-year older girl can play in the tournament. **Before the first match the team list must be fulfilled.** The teams must play in numbered jersey.

### **Rules:**

#### Cross field:

- penalty field 9m
- penalty kick from 9m
- wall distance 5m
- back-pass: according to standard field rules
- bringing the ball into the game: the goalkeeper can do it with hands and feet as well
- corner: also from the goalkeeper
- throw-in: there is no throw-in, the ball can be brought to game by flat pass (the other team's players stand 3m far)
- offside: yes

#### Small field:

- penalty kick from 7m
- wall distance 3m
- back-pass: according to standard field rules
- bringing the ball into the game: the goalkeeper can do it with hands and feet as well
- corner: also from the goalkeeper
- throw-in: there is no throw-in, the ball can be brought to game by flat pass (the other team's players stand 3m far)
- offside: no

**Disciplinary measures:** in U13, U12 age group there are yellow and red cards. In other age groups there are 2 minutes penalty and final order off. The player who was ordered off can play at the following match, except the Competition Committee do not let it.

**Other information:** Every player has to bring the membership card or students' card and the personal insurance card, which has to be shown if other team asks it. The cards can only be checked by the other teams before the match, after the match it can't be the subject of protest. In moot questions the Competition Committee makes its final decision, there is no protest. The provisions of football rulebook are applicable for the questions not mentioned here. Playing in cleated shoes are not permitted.

- Smoking is only permitted outside of the sport facility!
- Parents and accompanying can only stand out of the fence around the field.
- The head coach and team leader of each participating team shall bear full responsibility for the behavior and conduct of the parents and guardians affiliated with their team.
- There is possibility to dress up at the sport facility, but we are not responsible for the valuables left in the dressing rooms.
- Everyone participates at the cup at his/her own risk.
- Without medical permit players cannot participate at the cup. Before the first match the coach must declare on the team list that everyone has the medical permit.
- Medical service is provided by the colleagues of the local ambulance service at the sport faculty during the whole cup.
- For the peace of the surrounding residents, we ask that you do not use drums, whistles, horns or other noise-making devices during the tournament!

**Prize:** The best three teams of every age group get a cup and medals. In every age group special prize is given to the best goalkeeper, best fieldsman and to the top scorer.
